New IWF members will embody/represent/live/advance the mission of IWF Chicago by meeting the following criteria:

Suggested Criteria for Potential Member Candidates

- 1) Employed full-time, and one of the highest ranking women in her corporation and/or profession
- 2) Demonstrated leadership in her profession and community.
- 3) Demonstrated global citizenship through her career or other activities.
- 4) Demonstrates interest in both the Chicago chapter and the International Women's Forum itself.
- 5) Committed and available to actively participate in IWF events and committees, regardless of where she resides.
- 6) Fills a void in our leadership vision of diversity, including industry sector, private/public/not-for-profit, race, generation, etc.
- 7) Role, or public profile, is a clear asset to IWF.

NOTE: Past fellows from Illinois will be considered for membership after fulfilling the two year legacy program, having met the requirements of Membership.

ADDITIONAL NOTE ON AFFILIATE MEMBERS: Members from other IWF affiliate Forums relocating to Illinois will become members with a letter of recommendation from their prior Forum's President.
